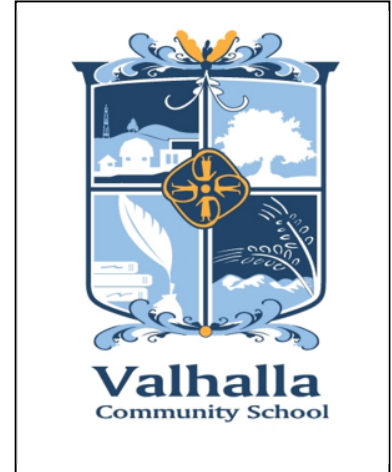

Tuesday, Mar.1 from 3:30pm to 5pm, followed by refreshments to end the season.

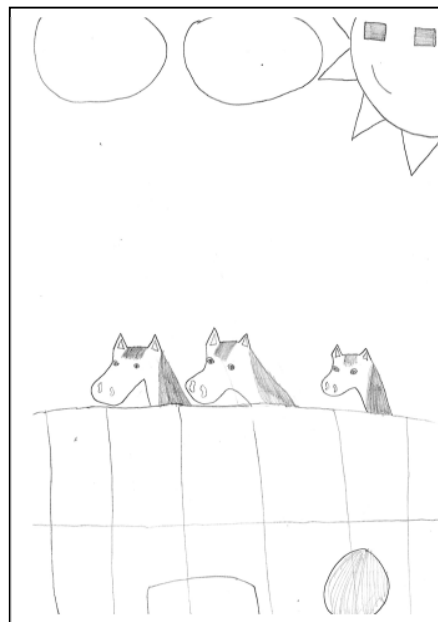
Badminton begins in March. If you have some talents in this field and are interested in coaching, please give the school a call.
