## VCS Welcomes Charter Review Team!

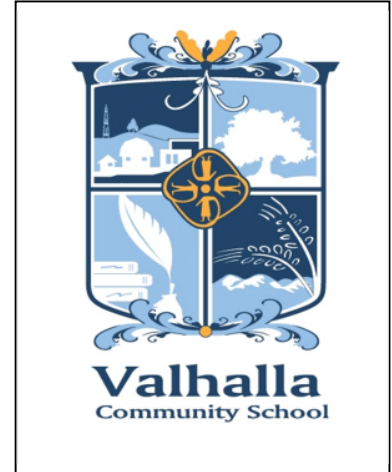
Well, it's finally here! The Charter School Review process which we've been working toward all year is culminating this week with the on-site review visit.

Today we wish to extend a warm Valhalla Community School welcome to Mr. Dave van Tamelen and his colleague, Mr. Dale Bischoff. These men will be visiting our school all this week, so if you see them stop and introduce yourself and make them feel at home.

The team, conducting a review for Alberta Education (which is mandatory for all Charter schools every five years), is tasked with making a determination as to how well our school is realizing the goals we set out to reach when we applied for charter school status.

The men will be looking closely into all aspects of our school. They'll interview parents, students, staff and board members. They'll observe some classes. They'll review surveys done by parents, students and staff. They've already reviewed reams of school documents prepared earlier by our staff.

It's a great opportunity for us as a school to show Alberta Education what a great thing we have going on here! It's a ready-made tool to help us discover what we might be able to do even better! It's time to "...let our little light shine"!

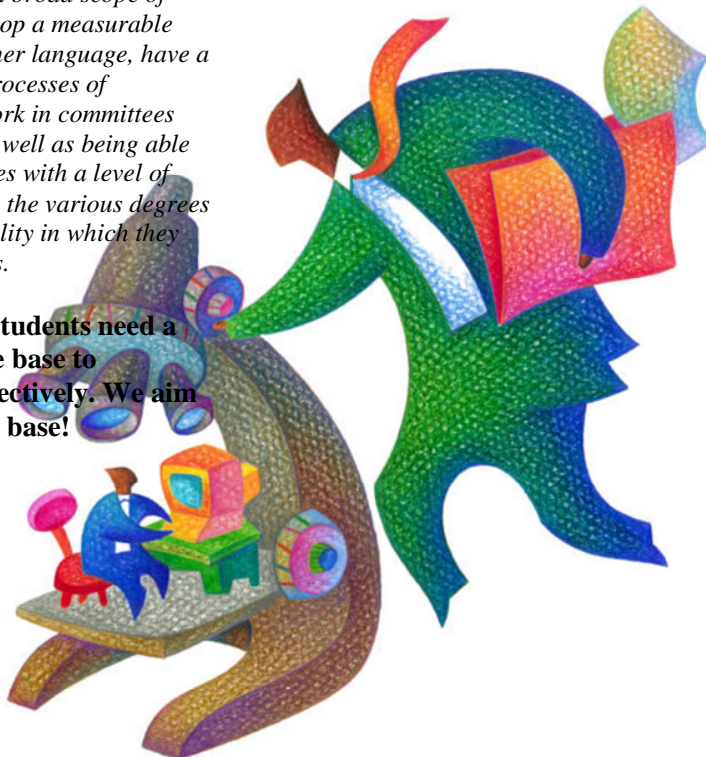

*Excerpt from VCS Charter*

*With the intent of training students to be able to competently embrace leadership opportunities as they arise, the VSF values its students acquiring a body of knowledge to enable them to function comfortably in a wide variety of situations in both urban and rural settings.
