Students are encouraged to **bring a snack** for after they swim as they are often starving following their lesson. The bus will return to the school in time for regular home time. On non-kindergarten days parents will need to bring their kindergarten student to the school for 11:40am, the kindergarten students will return home on the bus at the end of the day.

Thursday, November 18th the grades 3 & 4, 5 & 6 students will begin swim program. They will swim Nov. 18th, 19th, 23rd, 24th, 25th and 26th. Each group will have 6 days of lessons.

Poppies have now arrived at the office. Students are encouraged to bring a donation of a quarter, or a loonie or a toonie and pick up a poppy.

Now that winter is arriving, we would like to ask parents to remind **children** to be **dressed for the weather** (boots on, mitts and toques along) in order that they are prepared **in the event** of bus trouble en route.
