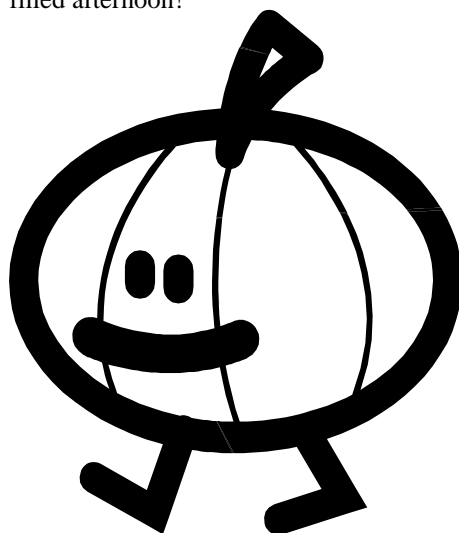


Fall Harvest School Celebration!
