## Terry Fox Run and Fundraisers a HUGE Success at VCS!

Congratulations are in order! After weeks of planning, organizing and running fund raising events to raise money for cancer research, September 24<sup>th</sup> arrived with perfect weather for the Terry Fox Run itself.

Each class at VCF, from grade 1/2 to grade 7/8, put together their own event in support of Terry Fox: grade 1/2 had a fruit sale, grade 3/4 did a bake sale-lemonade sale, grade 5/6 had a Second Look (garage) sale, and grade 7/8 held a concession sale, candy jar guess and raffle.

Final fundraising results are outstanding:

Grade 1/2 - \$220.25

Grade 3/4 - \$216.60

Grade 5/6 - \$424.36

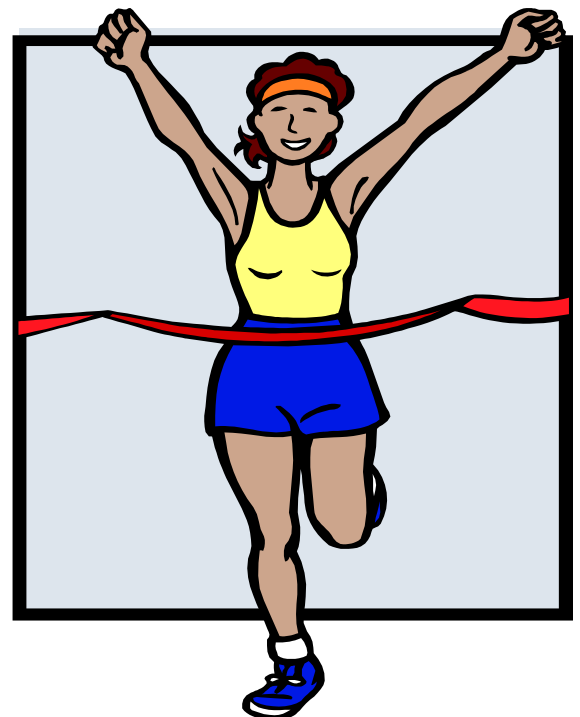
Grade 7/8 - \$452.39

Frau Bratland contributed fresh baked bread which brought in \$48.14 worth of donations and \$15 in other donations came in. The school total for the entire fundraising event was **\$1376.74!**

Our appreciation also goes out this week to Darcy and Allan Tofteland for supplying new gravel for our bus lane and parking area.

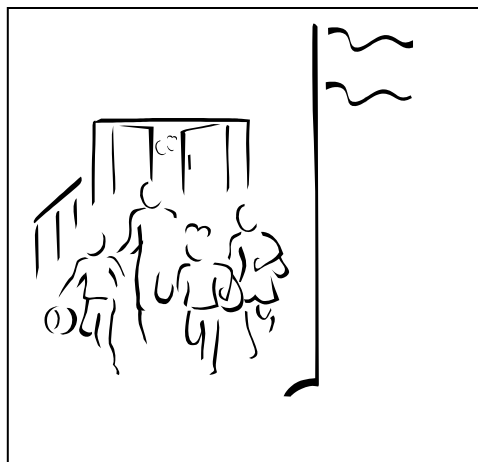
And thanks again to Pete Tofteland for supplying his bobcat and operator to level the gravel.

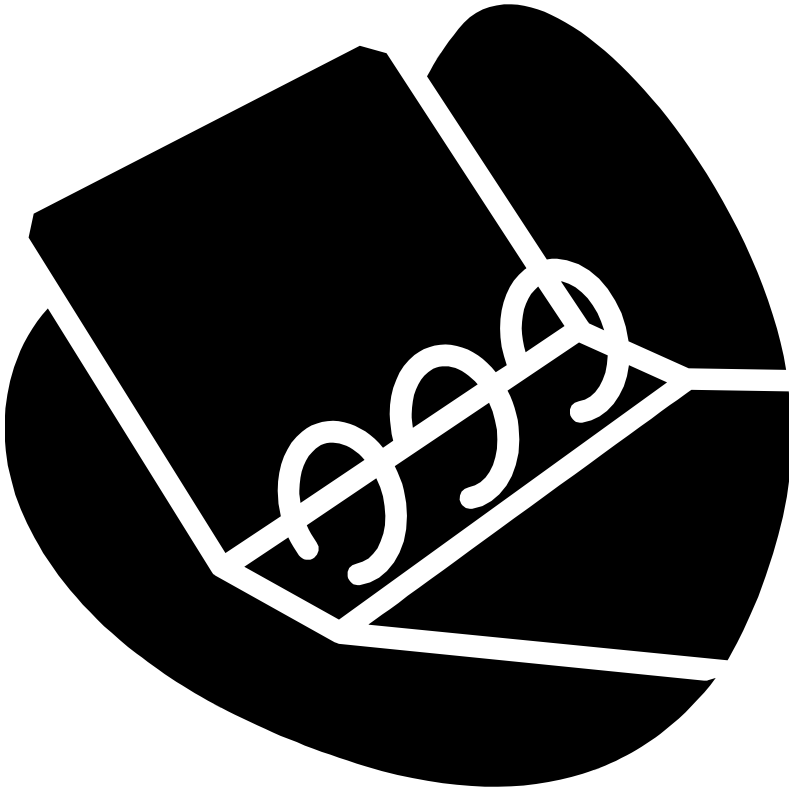
